Frederick Kahler is an visionary artist who creates unique drawings and etchings in extremely intricate detail using watercolor, steel tipped pen and ink, without the use of any magnification. Fred's visual story-telling language is infused with philosophy and mythology, depicting ancient landscapes and metaphysical themes that comprise greater overall compositions.

A self taught artist, and founding member of the Sperryville ARTist Cooperative, Fred's drawings have been acquired by renowned collectors both nationally and internationally, and he was honored to have his work added to the collections of the Smithsonian American Art Museum, Washington, DC; Museum of Fine Arts, Boston MA; Philadelphia Museum of Art, Philadelphia PA and American Visionary Art Museum, Baltimore, MD., before his passing in February of 2018.
