

## Clive Pates

As a painter, Clive Pates is a gesturalist, unsentimentally representing his subject with brush and knife work and sculpturally describing space. A student of Conceptual Art, Clive then moved beyond it to re-examine the perceptual world with a new perspective. With no regard for fashion, he works instead to find relevance for painting and human connection in a post-Art World.

Clive Pates' paintings are exhibited internationally, and he has been recognized throughout his career with awards such as a British Fulbright Scholarship, three Elizabeth Greenshields Foundation grants, two Andy Warhol Foundation Grants, and a Mississippi Artist Fellowship, as well as residencies in Ireland, Scotland, Italy and Arizona. His work is in the permanent collections of the Phippen Museum of Art and the Mississippi Museum of Art.
