I have been doing watercolors since 2005. Before that I worked in several other genres—art pottery, photography and narrative story writing. In watercolors, I have found a medium that truly speaks to my soul.

Although my husband and I now live in Jeffersonton, Virginia, we lived in Rappahannock County for fourteen years on a beautiful farm with vineyards, a B & B, and a river running through it. The magnificent views of fields, forests, and the Blue Ridge Mountains continue to inspire my art.

I was born and raised in California and lived for many years in Malibu, California, very near the ocean, another beautiful setting. We now have a second home on Cape Cod in Massachusetts very close to the water, with incredible sunrises & sunsets, which has been another source of themes for my watercolors. Nature has always been the primary inspiration for my art.

I am very eclectic in what I paint. In most cases I don't know what I'm going to paint until just before I start—and love starting with the simple process of mixing colors. I get great satisfaction from the many unexpected effects that come from working with watercolors. Some of my paintings are interpretations of photos I have taken, a few are sparked by pictures I have seen, and others--mostly my abstracts--just come out of my head.

Most of my watercolors are on display at Gallery 3 in Sperryville, Virginia. I have also been a member of Middle Street Gallery and River District Artists, both located in Washington, Virginia. I have had special shows at the Upper Deck Gallery in Orleans, Massachusetts (Cape Cod); Fauquier Hospital in Warrenton; and Narmada Winery in Amissville.
